Traffic speed is decisive on pedestrian casualties due to the combined effect of kinetic energy and braking distance. Yet there is little published information on traffic speeds in our urban areas. This event involves hands-on speed survey on urban streets led by Laser Tech Asia staff and CRS members. Participants will have the opportunity to experience the use of the latest laser speed measurement technology to record the speed of vehicles on urban streets. This exercise will be preceded by a briefing session with drinks and light meals followed by a wrap-up session.”
